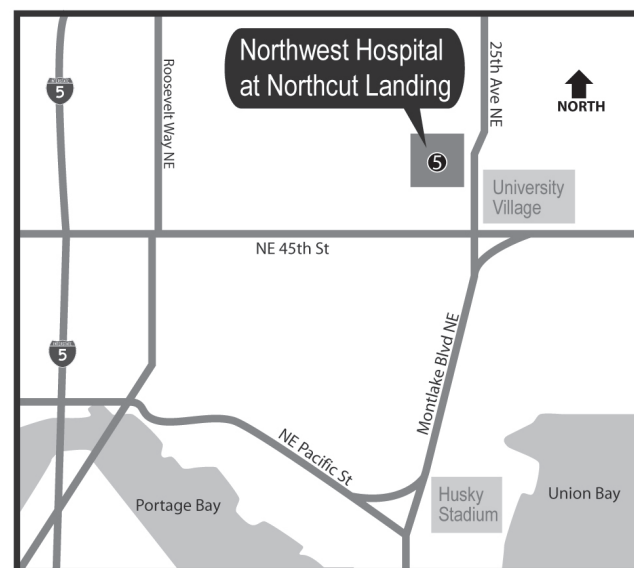

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Northwest Hospital & Medical Center:
(Free parking on Saturdays)

From I-5 North or South

- Take Exit 173
- Turn west on Northgate Way

To Main Campus

- At Meridian Ave N, turn right (North)
- Take the first left onto N 115th St
- Entrance will be on your right

To Outpatient Medical Center

- At Meridian Ave N, turn left (South)
- Entrance is approximately .3 miles on your left

NWH Lab Services at Northcut Landing:

Traveling North on I-5

- Take Exit 169 toward NE 45th St
- Merge onto 7th Ave NE
- Turn right at NE 45th St
- Sharp right at Montlake Blvd NE
- Sharp right at 25th Ave NE
- Entrance will be on your left

Traveling South on I-5

- Take Exit 172 toward NE 80th St
- Stay left and go over freeway
- Move instantly over to the right lane
- Turn right onto Banner Way NE
- Follow Banner Way NE as it curves to the left and becomes NE 75th St
- Continue on NE 75th St
- Turn right at NE 25th Ave
- Entrance will be on your right

- Patients requiring both laboratory and imaging services
- Patients who need to recline while having their blood drawn
- Bariatric patients
- Patients requiring specialty laboratory tests including the following:
 - Arterial blood gases (ABG)
 - Timed glucose tolerance tests (GTT)
 - Ammonia
 - Lactic acid
 - Infant PKU's and other tests requiring heel-sticks
 - Stimulation testing (Ex. TSH, cortisol)
 - Requests for crossmatch, type & screen, or hold for possible cross-match blood components including red cells, platelets, FFP or cryo-precipitate
